

LORAIN COUNTY SOCCER COACHES ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE

To provide scholarship awards for male and female senior high school student-athletes whose head varsity coaches are members in good standing of the Lorain County Soccer Coaches Association (“in good standing” is defined as having no outstanding dues or fines as of the October LCSCA meeting) and who have achieved the scholastic, athletic, and community service requirements for this award.

REQUIREMENTS

The athlete during his/her high school soccer career must have demonstrated or achieved recognition in the three areas noted below. It is the intent of the committee to recognize the athletes who not only demonstrate soccer skill or achievements, but who have excelled in the classroom and have made contributions to area youth soccer programs.

- 1) Achievement of a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average as of the end of the junior year and the intention to continue with post-secondary education.
- 2) A member of the soccer program at his/her high school for four years. League recognition is not a requirement as much as the personal commitment and dedication to the team and soccer community.
- 3) Demonstrated activity in local youth soccer programs to encourage youth participation, train/educate players in soccer skills, coach, or referee local games.

A committee of LCSCA coaches will evaluate all players applying for the award according to these requirements and make the final selections (NOTE: No member of the committee may vote for his/her own players). All senior players of head varsity coaches (who are members in good standing of the LCSCA) at the end of the regular season are considered eligible for the award.

AWARD

The award will be a minimum amount of \$500 per scholarship (or as determined by the LCSCA board) per recipient (one male and one female). The award will be presented at intermission of the LCSCA All-Star Games.

PROCEDURE

Applicants need to complete the LCSCA Scholarship Award Application and submit it to the LCSCA Scholarship Committee Chairperson or the President of the LCSCA by **November 1st** with the following:

- 1) An official transcript or statement signed and dated by his/her guidance counselor attesting to his/her grade point average;
- 2) A statement signed and dated by his/her varsity soccer coach recommending the committee’s consideration of the applicant for the award;
- 3) Any supplemental information the applicant wishes to submit to assist the committee in determining the applicant’s suitability for the award.
